Finally, the Reunion Dates have been finalized for our annual reunion in Branson Missouri. The reunion is scheduled to take place on October 6-10, 2024 in Branson, Missouri. The Hotel we selected is the Hilton at the Branson Convention Center.

The address is 525 Branson 10, Landing Blvd 65616. The phone Number is 417-335-7000 and the rates are \$169.00 per night plus tax. Parking is \$10.00 per day. Hotel Reservations must be made by, each individual, with the hotel. Hotel rates are good for 3 days before and 3 days after the reunion. Cost of registration for the hospitality suite and gatherings Plus is \$36.70 per person per day and the cancellation insurance is \$24.95 per person.

Hotel breakfast note: The standard cost of the full breakfast buffet at the hotel is \$19.95, They offer it for a discounted rate of \$17 if you select it when you reserve your room. You can have a smaller breakfast off their menu for less than \$19. If you want a big breakfast their \$17 offer is a good deal, however, if you eat a smaller breakfast, you may be better off not paying for the full buffet. See their menu following the Itinerary.


What you saw at the reunions was Marshall 55+ years ago. We will miss you, Marshall, and our sincere sympathy and prayers continue to go out to Linda and family.
